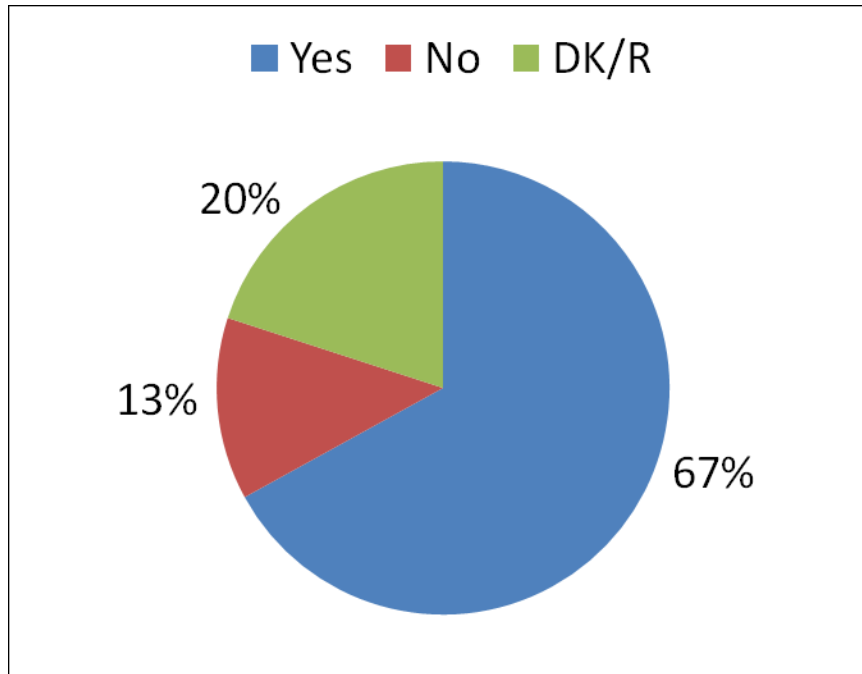

What do Nigerians think of aid agencies and their impact?

- 2 out of 3 Nigerians say aid is good



Differences exist across gender, age, education:

70% males say aid is good but 64% females

71% aged 20 – 29 say aid is good compared with 64% for those aged 30 – 45

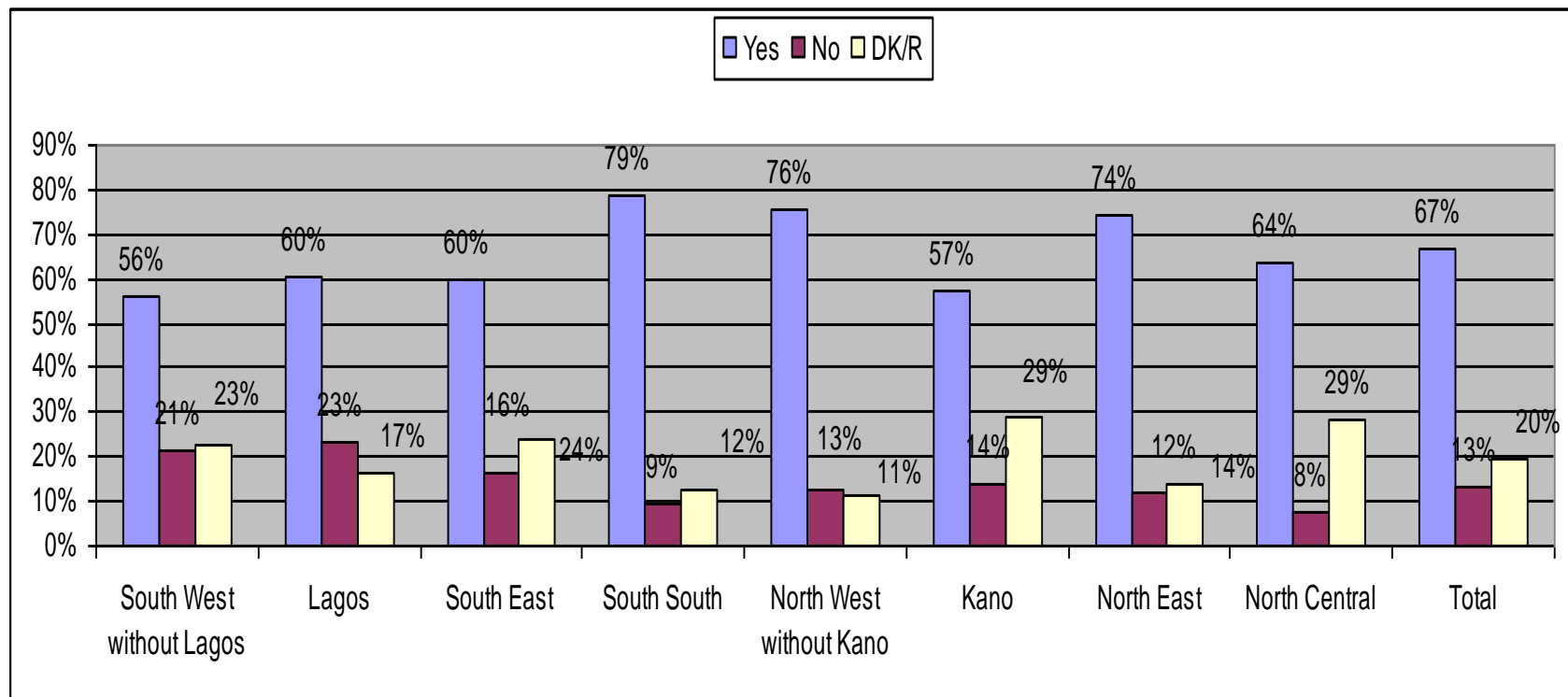
80% with at least some tertiary education say aid is good compared with 65% of those without tertiary education

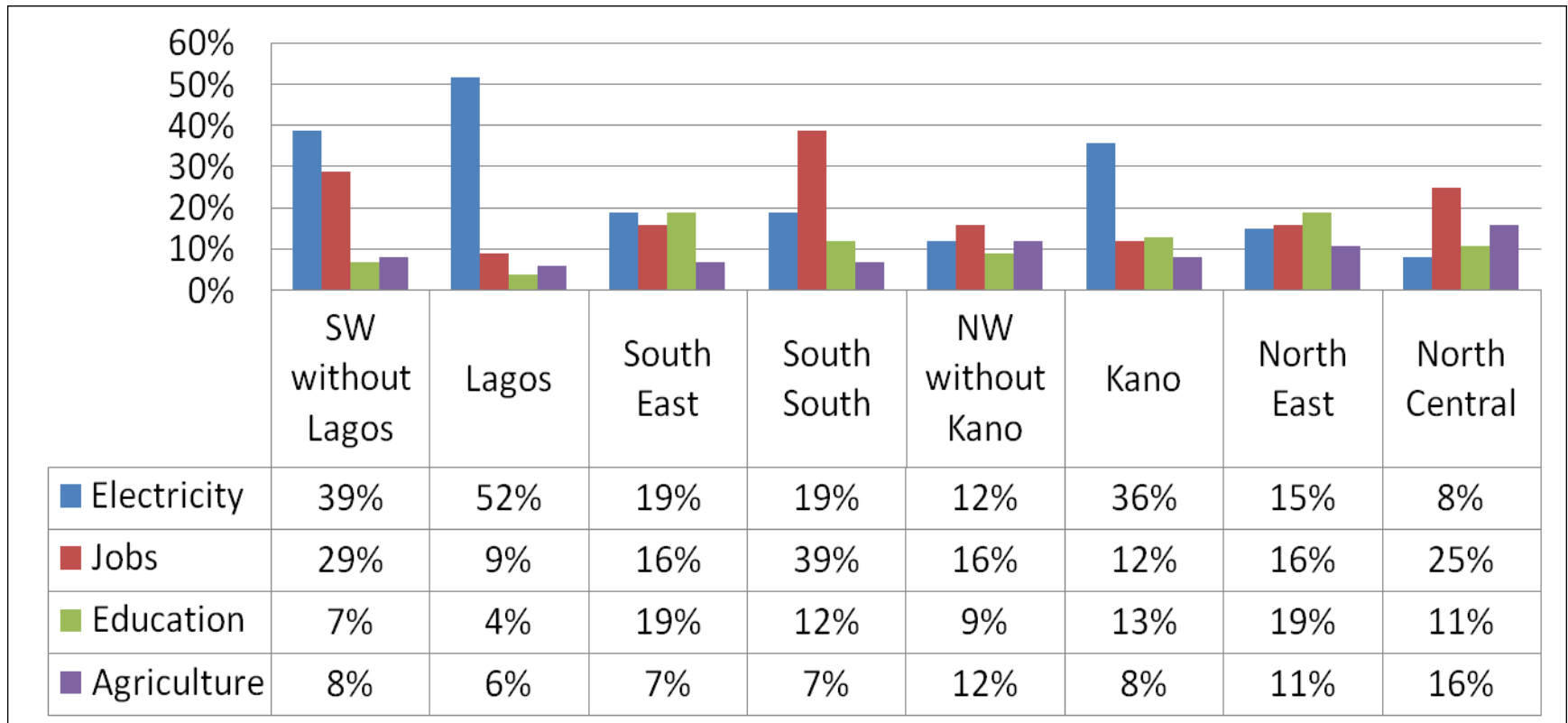

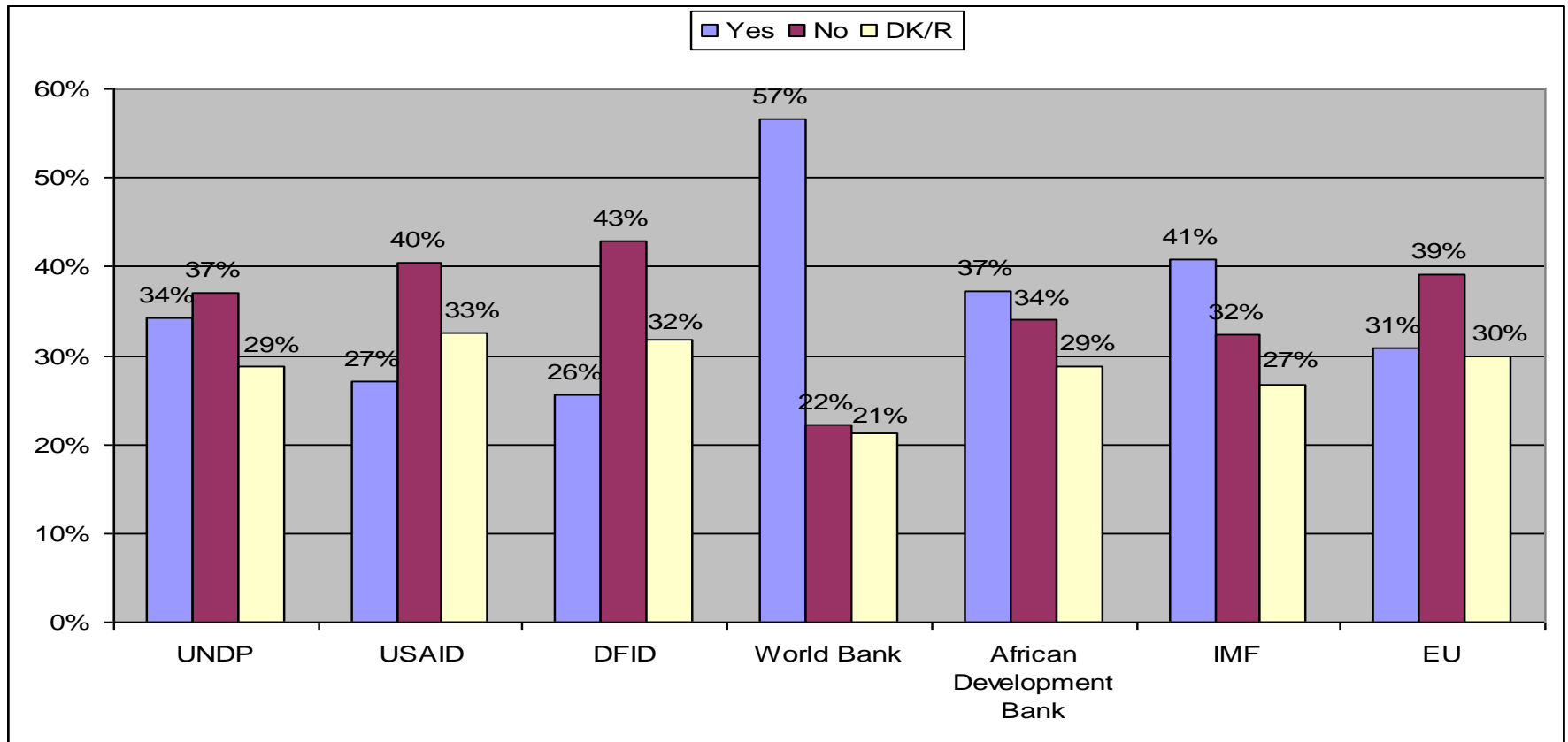

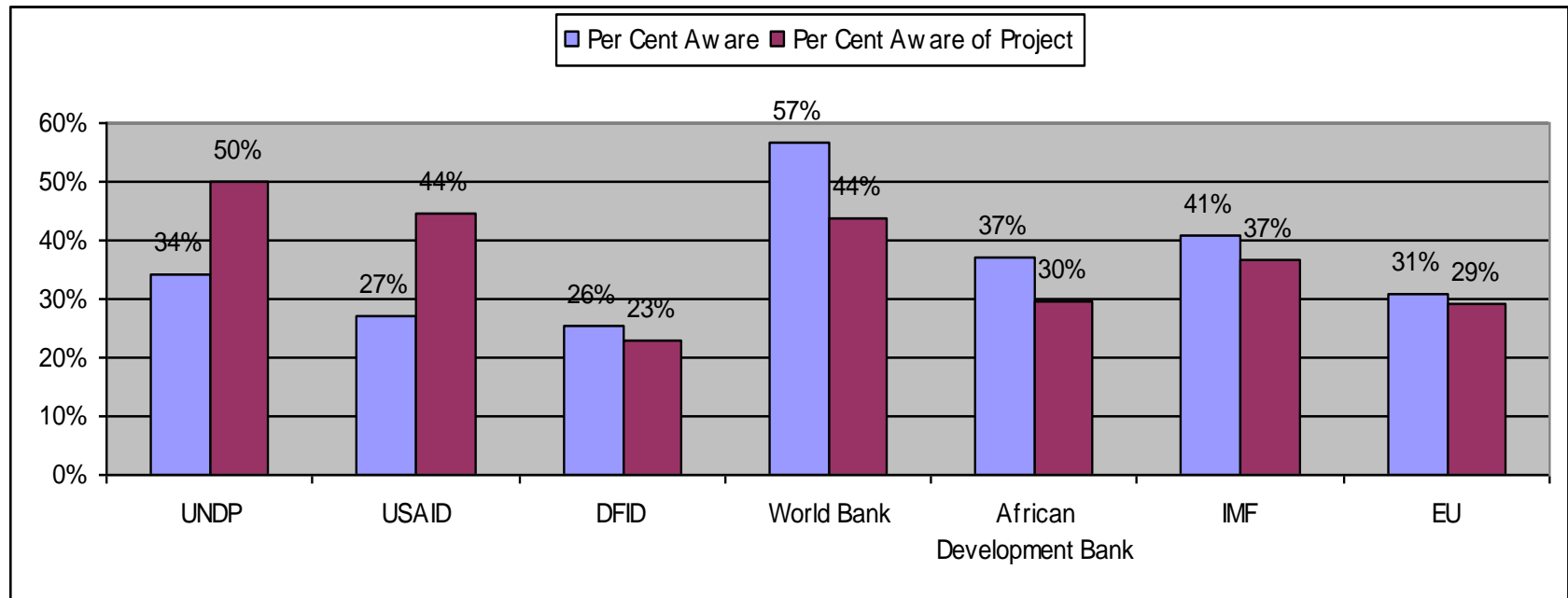
- World Bank(57%), IMF (41%) and AfDB (37%) have highest level of recognition
